



COVID-19 UPDATE: OUR COMMITMENT TO SAFETY

At Job Haines Home, there is nothing more important to us than the health and well-being of our residents, caregivers, and staff.

With that in mind, we would like you to know about the following precautions we are taking to minimize the impact of the Coronavirus.

- We have a comprehensive policy in place, based upon information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which we review daily.
- We are continuously cleaning and disinfecting; we have instituted a strict policy for infection control and hand washing for our entire staff.
- We are not allowing any outside visitors into the building.
- We are taking the temperature of all staff members including administration 2 times a day; once before they enter the building and then a 2nd time during their shift.
- We are taking the temperature of all residents 3 times a day on each shift.
- We are utilizing Facetime so residents can stay in touch with their families.
- We will be creating a Facebook group which you can join and we will be posting photos there so you can see photos of your loved ones.
- We are continuing to monitor the situation and will act accordingly to ensure the health and safety of our residents, caregivers, and staff.
