VISITORS VISITATION GUIDELINES

- Residents have the right to choose visitors and to make preferences.
- Visitors must complete the COVID-19 Risk Informed Consent before they are allowed to visit.
- Visitors **Must** comply with the Home's COVID screening process **prior to entering the building** and **MUST** wear a facemask at all times.
- Visitors should limit surfaces touched. (i.e., table).
- Food is not permitted during the visit. Visitors may bring items for the resident but must leave the package with the Screener.
- Visitors should wait in their vehicle/outside until their scheduled appointment time.
- Residents may not have more than two visitors.
- Visitors must use hand sanitizer before and after each visit.
- Visitation will occur outside in Nursing Unit courtyard, weather permitting.
- Visitors and residents must practice social distancing at all times and be at least six feet apart from each other.
- Visitors may not touch or hug a resident.
- Visiting times are limited to no more than 30 minutes in length so that other residents can have an opportunity to have visitors.
- Visitors must arrive on time for their scheduled visit. Visitors who are ten (10) minutes late may need to reschedule.

- Any change to scheduled visit including person(s) who will be visiting must call 24 hours in advance to the facility, 973-743-0792 with your changes.
- Children under the age of 14 are not permitted to visit.
- Pets are not allowed to visit at this time.
- Visitors are not permitted entrance in the reception area of the facility.
- Visitors are not permitted to use the Home's restrooms.
- Visitors may bring their own water which cannot be shared with the residents.
- Visitors should contact the Home and their Healthcare provider if they develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 within 14 days of their visit to the Home.
