Dear Residents and Families:

Since my last communication, testing of staff has turned up no other asymptomatic employees that tested positive for COVID-19.

Therefore, our current numbers for this new outbreak remain as follows:

- 0 residents who have tested positive for COVID 19
- 5 center staff that have tested positive for COVID 19
- 0 residents have passed away due to COVID 19 during this pandemic
- 0 center staff has passed away due to COVID 19 during this pandemic

This still means that we are still in Phase Zero and must remain closed to all visitors. We cannot reopen to any form of visitation until we are permitted by the local and state Departments of Health.

Please watch our website, www.job-haines.org and Facebook for updates. We will be posting Activity calendars and menus along with pictures of resident and staff activities. We are also working on a new communication system to residents and families. This system is compatible with our medical record system and can quickly send out messages via text, email and voice. We are looking for a start date of November 1st. There is nothing that you will need to do in order to receive these messages. If you have any questions, you can also call into the main number and ask for extension 121 and leave a message or my extension 114. Please stay tuned for updates via a weekly conference call or zoom with myself.

I understand that this is frustrating that we are back to Phase Zero, but it is necessary due to the frail population that we serve and to try to protect them as best as possible. Please remember that you can call to set up either a FaceTime visit or "breezeway visit" Monday through Friday, unless the resident is under their initial 14 day quarantine from admission.
