Dear Residents and Families:

My last communication stated that our weekly testing results showed four asymptomatic staff members, test positive for COVID-19. The local Bloomfield Board of Health and the New Jersey Department of Health were immediately notified of these results, and they consider this to be a new COVID-19 outbreak. Last week's weekly testing of staff turned up another asymptomatic employee that tested positive for COVID-19.

Our current numbers for this new outbreak are as follows:

0 residents who have tested positive for COVID 19  
5 center staff that have tested positive for COVID 19  
0 residents have passed away due to COVID 19 during this pandemic  
0 center staff has passed away due to COVID 19 during this pandemic

This news means that we are still in Phase Zero and must remain closed to all visitors. We cannot reopen to any form of visitation until we are permitted by the local and state Departments of Health.

I am always available to discuss the numbers in general terms since I must maintain our resident's and staff's privacy.
